Concentrated Carpet Cleaner

1. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Highly effective cleaning concentrate. For robust, color and water-resistant carpets, textile floor coverings and upholstery made of synthetic fibers and wool.

- Contains high quality active cleaning agents.
- Reduces resoiling of the cleaned surface.
- With integrated stain remover, foam blocker and fresh-up formula for better air indoors.

2. APPLICATION

Thoroughly vacuum the carpet. Pretreat walkways and stubborn stains with Fresh Up 2in1. For normal soiling dilute Concentrated Carpet Cleaner in the mixture of 1:70 (give 150 ml to 10 litres water), give cleaning solution into the fresh water tank of a spray extraction machine. Clean the carpet according to the advice specificied on the cleaning appliance. Finally repeat the spray extraction procedure using clear water. Allow to dry thoroughly with good ventilation. Vacuum clean once again once dry.

Please note:

- Before use, test substrate for material suitability and colourfastness in an inconspicuous place.
- Avoid contact with sensitive surfaces (e.g., wood, metal, varnished surfaces).
- Beware of soaking when treating carpeting, especially materials and laying methods which are sensitive to moisture. Check adhesive installation to be water-resistant.
